Gardening Books At Library

As March comes in and the sun begins to warm up the earth, we get restless and long to be out of doors. Those of us who garden get our shovels and begin to dig up a plot of ground and plan what we are going to grow this season.

The library offers a wealth of information for both the amateur and the experienced gardener. There are books on planning a garden and the basics of preparing the beds and planting the seeds, to the more specialized books on orchids or herbs or annuals. The library also has a series of videos on gardening.

BOOKS
Ball, Jeff. The Self-Sufficient Suburban Gardener (Rodale Press, 1983). Tells how to get the most from a small space.

Bubel, Nancy. The New Seed-Starters Handbook (Rodale Press, 1988). Tells how to grow vigorous, healthy seedlings.

Fitch, Charles Marden. All About Orchids (Doubleday & Company, Inc., 1981). In-depth treatment of orchids, giving propagation techniques, varieties of orchids, growing in containers, diseases, and more.

Florance, Chris. Carolina Home Gardener (University of North Carolina Press, 1961). Gives a garden calendar for the Carolinas, listing the chores for each month, as well as more general information about pests, pruning, and planting.

Faust, Joan Lee. The New York Times Book Of Annuals and Perennials (Times Books, 1980).

Gives specific instructions for a large number of annual and perennial flowers, including type of soil water and sun requirements, flowering period, etc.

Foust, Joan Lee. The New York Times Book Of Vegetable Gardening (New York Times Book Company, 1975).

In addition to general information about soil prepa-

ration, planning and planting, this book gives specific instructions for a large number of vegetables.

Good Housekeeping Basic Gardening Techniques (Hearst Magazines, 1975).

Basic information on propagation and growing both vegetable and ornamental plants, as well as instructions for pruning, forcing plants, etc.

Growing and Preserving Your own Fruits and Vegetables (Jonathan David Publisher, 1975). Covers growing fruits and vegetables, and preserving by canning, freezing and pickling.

Harshbarger, Gretchen Fisher. McCall's Garden Book (Simon and Schuster, 1968).

Written by a landscape architect, this book covers planning and discusses plants suitable for various locations and problem areas.

Newcomb, Duane. The Complete Vegetable Garden's Sourcebook (Avon, 1980).

A compendium of information on the wide range of gardening equipment, tools, seed varieties, etc., and where they may be obtained.

Rice, Estelle H. Garden Hobbies (A.S. Barnes and Company, 1970).

Gives directions for designing small gardens, outdoor living spaces, decks, patios, pools, hydroponics, and more.

The Rodale Herb Book (Rodale Press, 1974).

Discusses a wide variety number of herbs, their history, growing requirements, and uses.

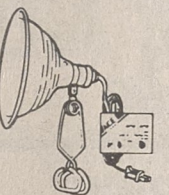
