

## Grading Underway At H&W

Grading is underway this week by H&W Systems Turbo Conveyors for a new manufacturing facility off Canterbury Road.

The plant will employ 80 people initially and will manufacture chip conveyors for the machine-tool in-

dustry.

President Kemble Widmer II said the new facility is expected to open in January 1990. The plant will utilize city services, water, gas, electricity and sewer.

H&W Conveyors operates two plants in Gastonia.

## Company To Open In KM

Southern Window Products has announced plans to open a manufacturing business in the current Cleveland Hosiery Building.

The company will employ 20 people during the first year of operation, with expansion to closely follow.

President Jerry Broadwell said Southern Window Products applies metalized backing to various fabrics

used as window coverings, ski wear, hot air balloons, and reflective surfaces for NASA.

Kings Mountain City Council recently voted to upgrade an electrical transformer to supply electricity to the new business which will also buy gas from the city.

Equipment, which is on order, is expected to be installed by July 1, Broadwell said.

## ESC Office Fills 77 Jobs

The Kings Mountain branch of the Employment Security Commission received 92 job openings and filled 77 of them during the month of May, according to statistics released today by the Employment Security Commission of North Carolina. Sixty-seven individuals were placed.

For the year, Kings Mountain has received 804 openings, filled 617 and placed 545 individuals in employment.

In North Carolina, 12,819 people found jobs through 78 job service centers and six branch offices. Employers listed 27,324 job openings with the agency during May and the ESC filled 16,928 of those openings.

Donations will be accepted at the Love Center during hours which will be posted on the door.

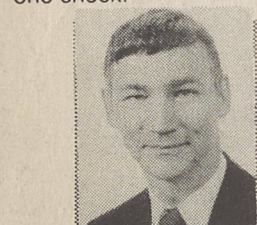
The Love Center collects toys, food, clothing, money, and other necessities for needy families in the area.
