Heading For Photo Finish

Is this a photo finish I see?

Heading into the last two weeks of the pigskin pickin', Stewart and Captain Hayes are neck and neck.

Stewart came out of a two-week slump last week to finish 14-2 and take a two-game lead over Hayes, who was 12-4. Flat Nose, the world-famous tree-climbing dog, was 11-5 and Corky Fulton, manager of Sagesport, was 10-6.

For the year, Stewart is 89-30 and Hayes is 87-32. Stewart said he considered going into a ball control offense and running out the clock by picking the same teams as Hayes, but he re-considered and is pickin' against Hayes on two games to give him a chance to tie the score and force a sudden death.

Dixon and his brother, Delbert, have been the clock and scoreboard operators for years for the Mountaineers and they're famous for their raw oysters and hot sauce which is served in the pressbox at halftime of each home game. When the Mountaineers win, they also share with the Mountaineer coaching staff. Coach Denny Hicks says the Dixons don't offer them any food on losing nights 'cause they figure the coaches don't feel like eating.

Kings Mountain High's soccer team will go into its final regular season match Saturday at 3 p.m. at St. Stephens needing a victory to grab the third state playoff seed from the Western Piedmont Conference.

Coach Dan Potter's team edged St. Stephens 3-2 last Wednesday night at KM's John Gamble Stadium to force a tie for third place between KM and St. Stephens. Hibriten and South Point have already nailed down the first and John Forrest to take a 3-1 lead two playoff berths.

The Mountaineers, in their first year of soccer, carried a 7-5 conference record and 9-5 overall mark into a match last night at home against Burns.

Jack Ladara scored off an assist by John Forrest to give the Mountaineers a 1-1 halftime tie against St. Stephens last week. The Mountaineers added goals in the second half by Keo Chanthaphaeng
