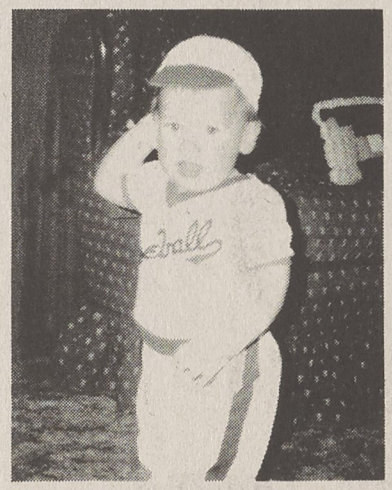
Hinsons Honored At Birthday Dinner Sunday
