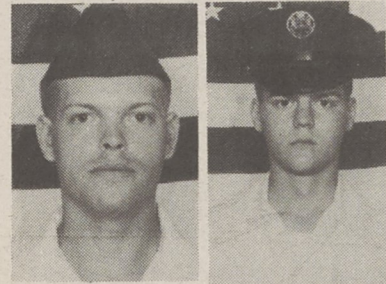
He is a military police specialist with the 82nd Military Police, Fort Bragg.

In addition, airmen who complete basic training earn credits toward an associate degree through

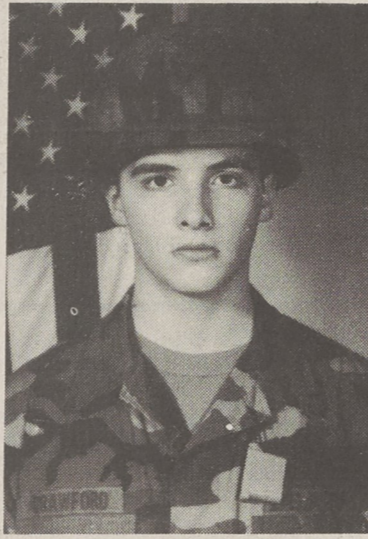
**Casey Shipman Completes Training**
