## Blaine All-American Scholar

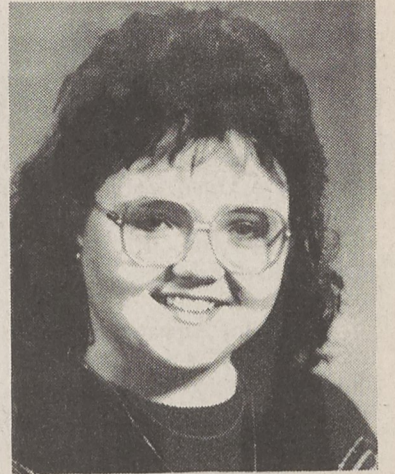
Lisa Blaine, daughter of Billy and Susan Blaine of Kings Mountain, has been named an All-American Scholar by the U.S. Achievement Academy.

### First Wesleyan Youth To Sponsor Car Wash

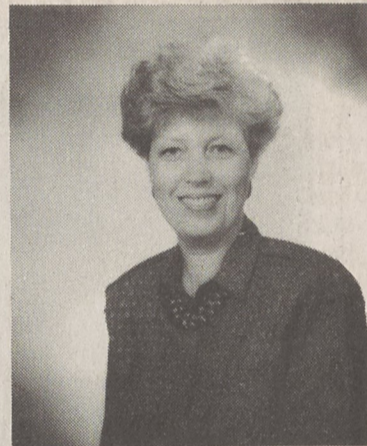
The youth of First Wesleyan Church will sponsor a car wash Saturday from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m. at the church on Piedmont Avenue.

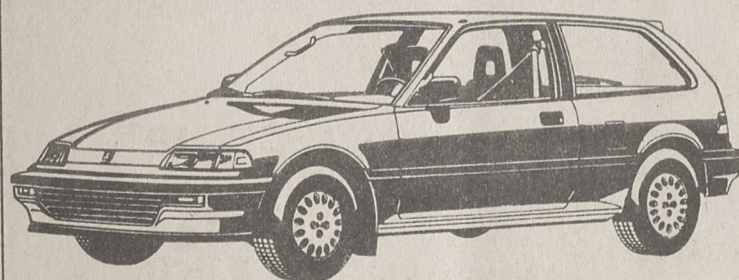
