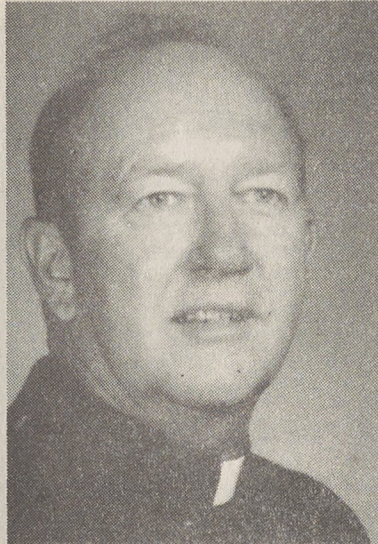

Gospel Singing Set For Sunday

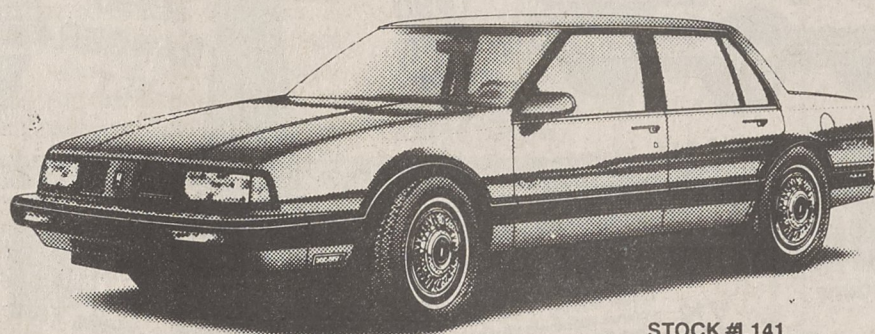
There will be a gospel singing Sunday at 7 p.m. at the Holiness Christian Mission, 215 Blanton Street, Kings Mountain.

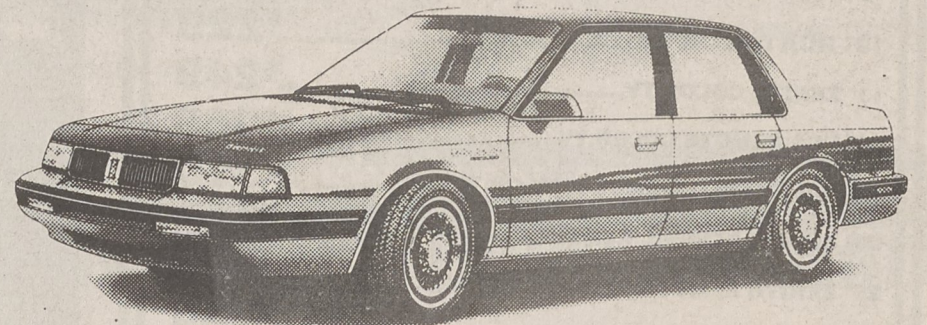

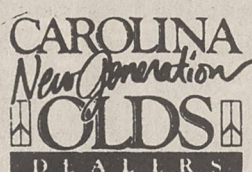

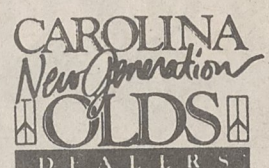
