## KMHS Third In Sectional Track Meet

Kings Mountain's Mountaineers finished third in the Sectional Track Meet last Thursday at East Henderson High School and will compete in the Western Regionals Saturday at Shelby.

North Buncombe won the event with 98 points. Shelby followed with 90 and KM had 81.

Victor Bell picked up the only two first places for the Mountaineers. He won the 400 meters in 53.20 seconds, edging Dean Lytle of Brevard who was the state champion last year in the 100 and 200 meters. Lytle is headed to Notre Dame on a track scholarship. Lytle's time was 53.59 seconds.

Bell also won the long jump with a leap of 21'3 1/2".

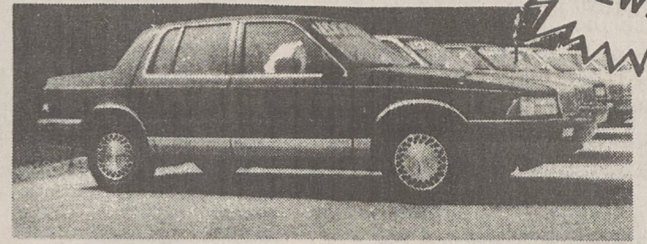

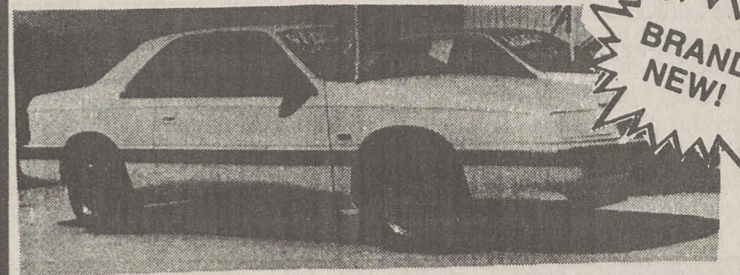

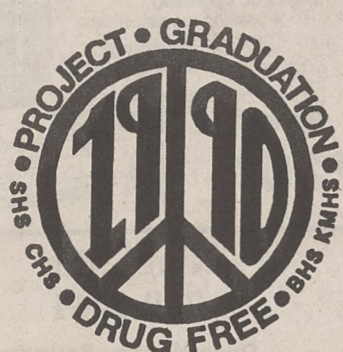
