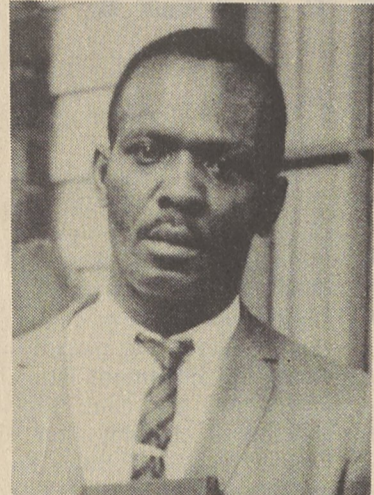

Pressley, a Cleveland County native, was son of the late Samuel Pressley.

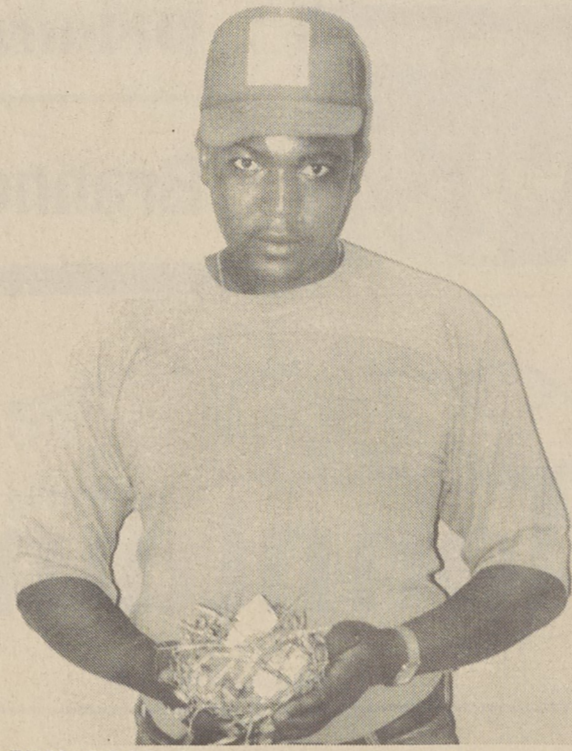
