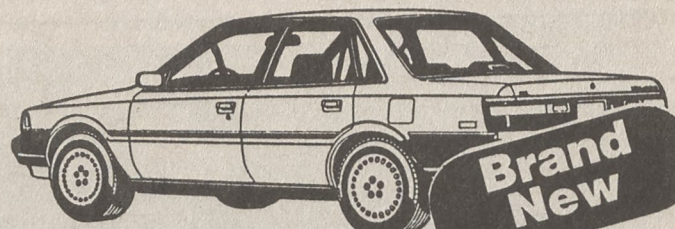
The future bridegroom was showered with "honey do this" gifts from the 50 friends who attended.

Guests showered Miss Sisk with towels, sheets and linens for her home.

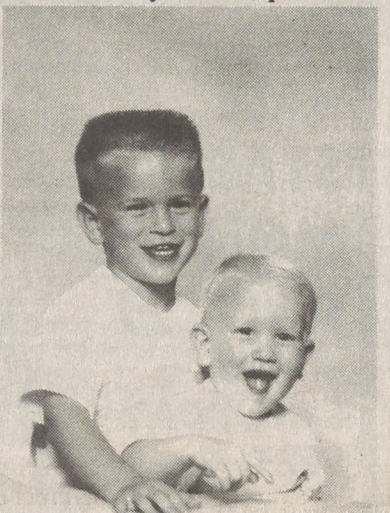
Miss Sisk and Edwin Brauns were married Aug. 11 in Kings Mountain Baptist Church.

He has a brother, Ben.

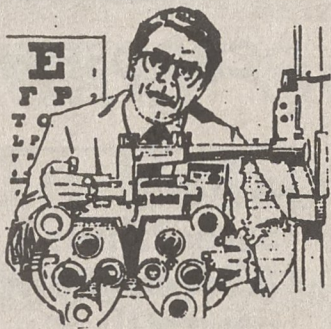
