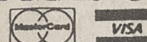

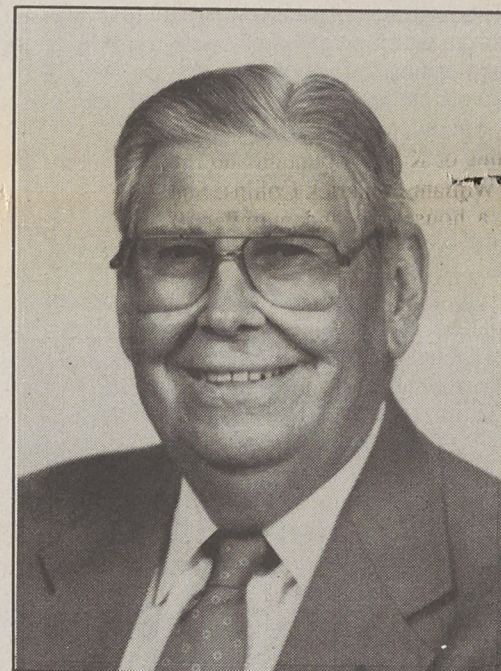
Dear Voters:
