

# KM swimmers have 6-0 mark

Kings Mountain High's swim team defeated Asheville and Chase Wednesday to run its record to 6-0.

Led by double winners Dave Messenger and Benji Davis, the Mountaineers scored 177 to outdistance Asheville at 105 and Chase with 23.

Additional first place winners were Aaron Allen, Brian Wilson and Chuck Kaylor in individual events, and James Faust, Patrick Frei, Dan Messenger and Lindsay Suber in relays.

The Kings Mountain girls continued their winning ways by downing Chase 145-83 and Asheville 145-55. They are now 5-1 with their only loss to Chase two weeks ago.

The KM ladies were paced by double winner Marine Mayse and single winners Sarah Dilling and Angela Blanton. Michelle Fujita, Leigh Kendrick and Paula Eckard teamed to win both the 200 medley and 400 free relays.

The Kings Mountain teams return to action January 8 when they host South Point.

She plans to soak her ham overnight in cold water and cook it gently, glazing with honey and cloves.

Mrs. Penfold loves Kings Mountain and especially the grocery stores.
