ly. Our goal is for **Good News** to become every Christian's means of keeping apprised to what's happening in our world.

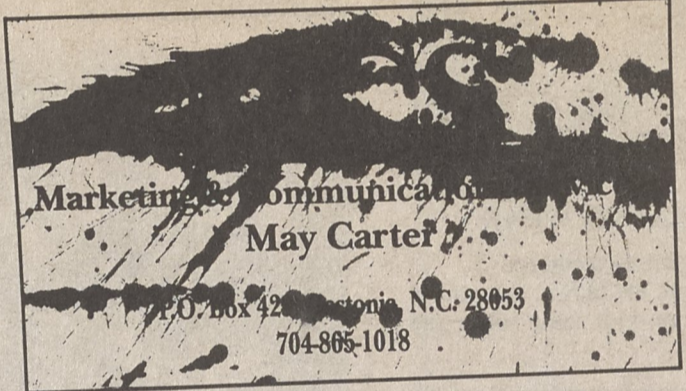
