ble education. She believes working together can make a difference. Cook has five years experience in the classroom and previously taught two years in Rutherford

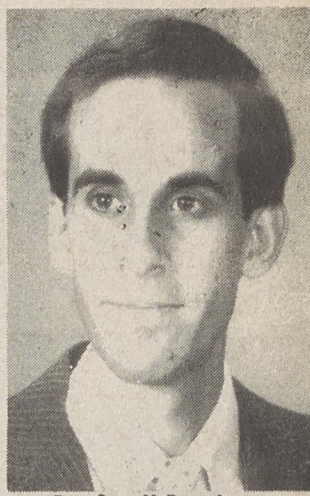
County and one year at Central School. Her family includes her brother, Warren, and her parents, Warren and Faye Cook. December's Teacher of the

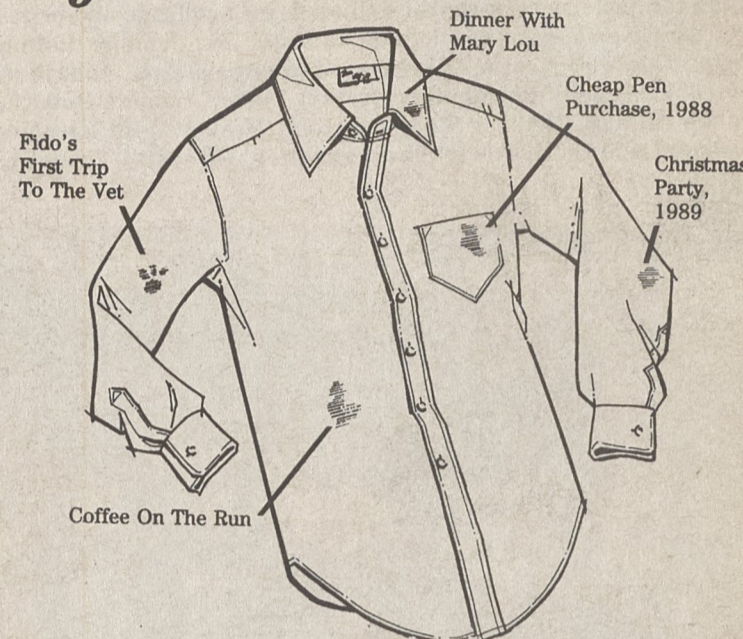
