The Westminster Singers will appear at the First

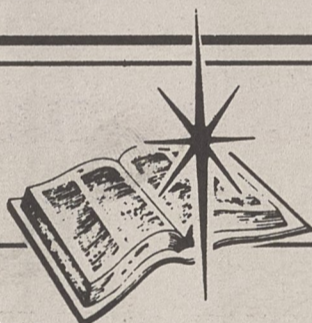
Presbyterian Church at 1621 East Garrison Boulevard in Gastonia on Sunday, March 8 at 7:30 pm.
