

Head Start recruiting children

Cleveland County Head Start is in process of recruiting children for the 1992-93 school year.

Families in Cleveland County who have children four years of age, or who will be four by October 16 this year, and have low to moderate incomes, regardless of race, sex, religion, national origin, or handicapping conditions, are qualified to apply.

Ten Head Start Centers are operated in the county, including

Centers at Bethware, Grover and North Elementary Schools.

A new classroom will be opened next year and parents are asked to express their choice of Elizabeth, Boiling Springs, Casar, James Love or Washington Schools for the site.

Applications may be picked up from any of the school sites or from the Head Start Office at Kings Mountain District Schools.

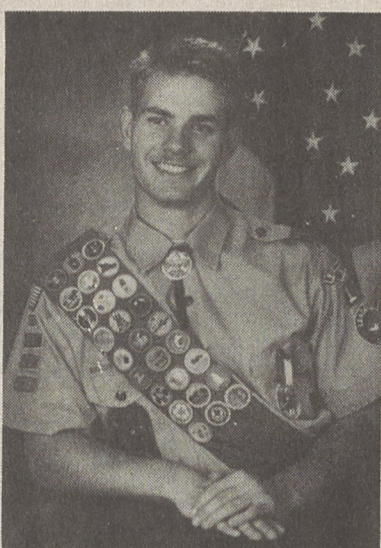
Justin Wright earns Eagle rank

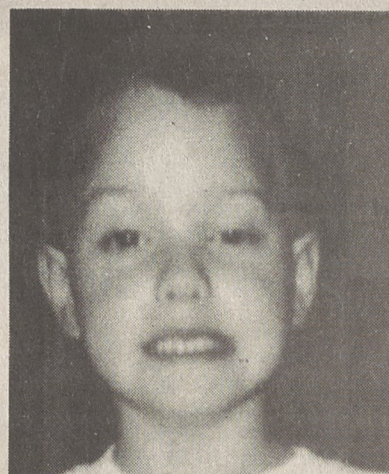
Wright is a member of Boy Scout Troop 17 of Kings Mountain, sponsored by Long Creek Presbyterian Church. He has

Reliance Electric is certified

The Engineered Motor Plant of the Reliance Electric Company has received international recognition by earning the International Organization of Standards (ISO) 9001 certification. The announcement was made here by A. A. Muren, Vice President of Reliance's Electrical Group.

Located in Kings Mountain, the Reliance plant manufactures engineered A-C and D-C motors from 100 to 3500 HP, which are used primarily in the petroleum and chemical, power utility, mining and papermaking industries. It is the first, and presently, the only electric motor manufacturing plant in the United States with ISO 9001 quality standard certification. Currently, there are approximately 225 sites nationwide that are registered to one of the ISO 9000 Series of Quality Standards.

ISO 9001 is one of five standards for quality that constitute the complete ISO 9000 Series of Quality Standards. It is the most comprehensive quality assurance model in the ISO 9000 series and covers business systems ranging from order entry to design and manufacture, through assembly, test and after sales service. The ISO 9000 Series is a quality standard recognized worldwide.

Reliance's Kings Mountain plant was granted certification by TÜV Rheinland, an accredited, independent third-party registrar headquartered in Bonn, Germany. TÜV conducted an extensive on-site audit of plant systems and op-

erations against the requirements of ISO 9001 standard. The plant certification is valid through January 1995.

On receiving the ISO 9001 certification, William Johnson, General Manager of the Kings Mountain facility, said "We are honored to have achieved the globally-recognized quality standard. In addition to reducing variability and ensuring control to the various

plant processes, this certification will introduce us to new market opportunities and improve our competitiveness. Quality is the first priority." He added that "Reliance Electric's objective is to have all of our facilities achieve certification to the ISO 9000 Series by the end of 1992. The Kings Mountain plant just happens to be the first."
