#### Groundbreaking for mental health facility

County's new mental health facility was held Monday at its new site located at 917 First Street in Shelby.

The new building is located just east of the facility on Crawford Street currently serving as the main center. It is tentatively scheduled to open in the spring of 1993.

The program to be housed in this facility serves people with mental and emotional needs, developmental disabilities, and alcohol and drug problems. Over 3,700 individuals were treated by the area program during 1991.

The 19,900 square feet of new finished space will allow for expansion of services for emotionally and physically abused children, substance abusers, and families needing therapy.

Last year, the North Carolina




