Conquest, Robert. **STALIN, BREAKER OF NATIONS** (Viking, 1991).

Of all the despots of our time, Joseph Stalin lasted the longest and wielded the greatest power, and his secrets have been the most jealously guarded, even after his death. This is the first book by a Western author to draw on the vast amount of material that became available in the aftermath of Glasnost, along with earlier official and unofficial sources, to produce a living portrait of this paranoid leader.

Cooley, John K. **PAYBACK: AMERICA'S LONG WAR IN THE MIDDLE EAST** (Brassey's Inc., 1991).

Cooley contends that many of the roots of today's Middle East turmoil are found in the U.S. Iran warfare that has flared intermittently since the fall of the Shah. He has drawn upon hundreds of public, private and secret sources on all sides of the issue and at the highest level of government. This is an insider's view of the long standing U.S. war in the Middle East.

Denckla, Tanya. **GARDENING AT A GLANCE: THE ORGANIC GARDENER'S HANDBOOK ON VEGETABLE, FRUIT, NUTS, AND HERBS** (Wooden Angel Publishing, 1991).

Davis, Patti. **THE WAY I SEE IT** (G.P. Putnam's Sons, 1992).

Finally, she has come to feel that it is only fair to them and to herself to set the record straight. He is a senior at Kings Mountain High School. He will receive his basic training at Ft. Leonardwood, Missouri, beginning June 15, 1993.

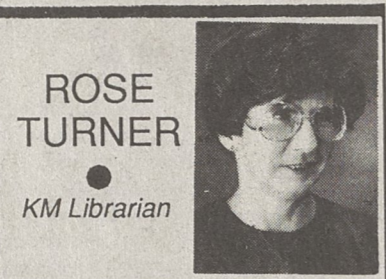

Writers, publishers, editors, librarians - anyone who works with words needs to know about copyright. This book provides forms and step-by-step instructions for protecting all types of written expression under U.S. and international copyright law.

Foner, Eric and John A. Garaty. **THE READER'S COMPANION TO AMERICAN HISTORY** (Houghton Mifflin Company, 1991).

This volume offers a fresh, absorbing portrait of the United States from the origin of the native peoples to the nation's complex identity in the 1990's. Covering political, economic, cultural, and social history, and combining hundreds of short descriptive entries with longer evaluation articles, the encyclopedia is informative, engaging, and a pleasure to read.

Gardner, Richard A. **SEX ABUSE HYSTERIA; SALEM WITH TRIALS**

REVISITED (Creative Therapeutics, 1991).

This book derives from the author's experience in child custody litigation over the last 25 years. He sees the use of the sex abuse accusation as a powerful weapon for wreaking vengeance on a hated spouse as well as obtaining court support for excluding a partner. He concludes that the majority of such accusations are false and sees it a national hysteria similar to the Salem witch trials in 1692.

Giancana, Sam and Chuck Giancana. **DOUBLE CROSS; THE EXPLOSIVE INSIDE STORY OF THE MOBSTER WHO CONTROLLED AMERICA** (Warner Books, 1992).

This is the book America has been waiting for. Hitherto unexplained mysteries behind the death of John F. Kennedy, Robert F. Kennedy, and Marilyn Monroe is elucidated in this chilling, intimate, portrait of life inside a Mafia family.

Ginsborg, Paul. **A HISTORY OF CONTEMPORARY ITALY: SOCIETY AND POLITICS, 1943-1988** (Penguin Books, 1990).

From a war torn and poverty stricken country, regional and predominantly agrarian, to the success story of the late 1980's, urbanized, secularized and competing with Britain for the position of the western world's fifth largest industrial nation, Italy has witnessed the most profound transformation in its entire history. This is the first major political and social history of Italy since 1943.

Glantz, Walter D., Kenneth N. Andrews, and Louis E. Andrews. **THE MOSBY MEDICAL ENCYCLOPEDIA, REVISED** (Plume, 1992).

Newly revised with more than 2,000 new entries, this is the most comprehensive resource available to answer all your questions about health care at home and in the hospital. It gives information on prescription drugs including generic and brand names and drug interactions, signs and symptoms of every major disease and its recommended treatment; definition of medical terms and latest information on pregnancy, child development and nutrition.

Gorbachev, Mikhail. **THE AUGUST COUP; THE TRUCH AND THE LESSONS** (Harper Collins Publishers, 1991).

This is the analysis of the causes and consequences of the coup d'etat that began on August 18. It is an account of how profound social transformation in the Soviet Union inevitably were accomplished by popular discontent over the hardships of daily life.

Gowans, Alan. **STYLES AND TYPES OF NORTH AMERICAN ARCHITECTURE; SOCIAL FUNCTION AND CULTURAL EXPRESSION** (Ican Editions, 1992).

This is the first fully illustrated, comprehensive study of North American buildings that integrates architectural styles and types with furniture, design, and social and cultural history from the seventeenth century to

the present. This book is about the relationship of buildings to cultural ideas and values and social function.

Greider, William. **WHO WILL TELL THE PEOPLE; THE BETRAYAL OF AMERICAN DEMOCRACY** (Simon & Schuster, 1992).

This is a passionate, eye opening challenge from a man determined to make us understand. Greider shows us the realities of power in Washington today, uncovering the hidden contours of relationships that link politicians with corporations and the rich and subvert the needs of ordinary citizens. He delineates the lines of battle in the struggle to save democracy.

Hatcher, Andrew. **TWO NATIONS; BLACK AND WHITE, SEPARATE, HOSTILE, UNEQUAL** (Charles Scribner's Sons, 1992).

This is the first book since 1944 to offer an up to date and profound analysis of the conditions that kept blacks and whites dangerously far apart in their ability to participate fully in the American democracy. Hacker analyzes the choices all Americans make in daily life and reveals exactly how deeply issues of race shape the thinking of all Americans.

Halberstam, David. **THE NEXT CENTURY** (William Morrow and Company, Inc., 1991).

Halberstam writes that the American century is over. In this book he takes a moment to discuss the lessons of his previous books to consider the recent past, astonishing events now taking place in the world, and the possible shape of the 21st century. This is a penetrating and thoughtful piece by one of our most valued social and cultural observers.
