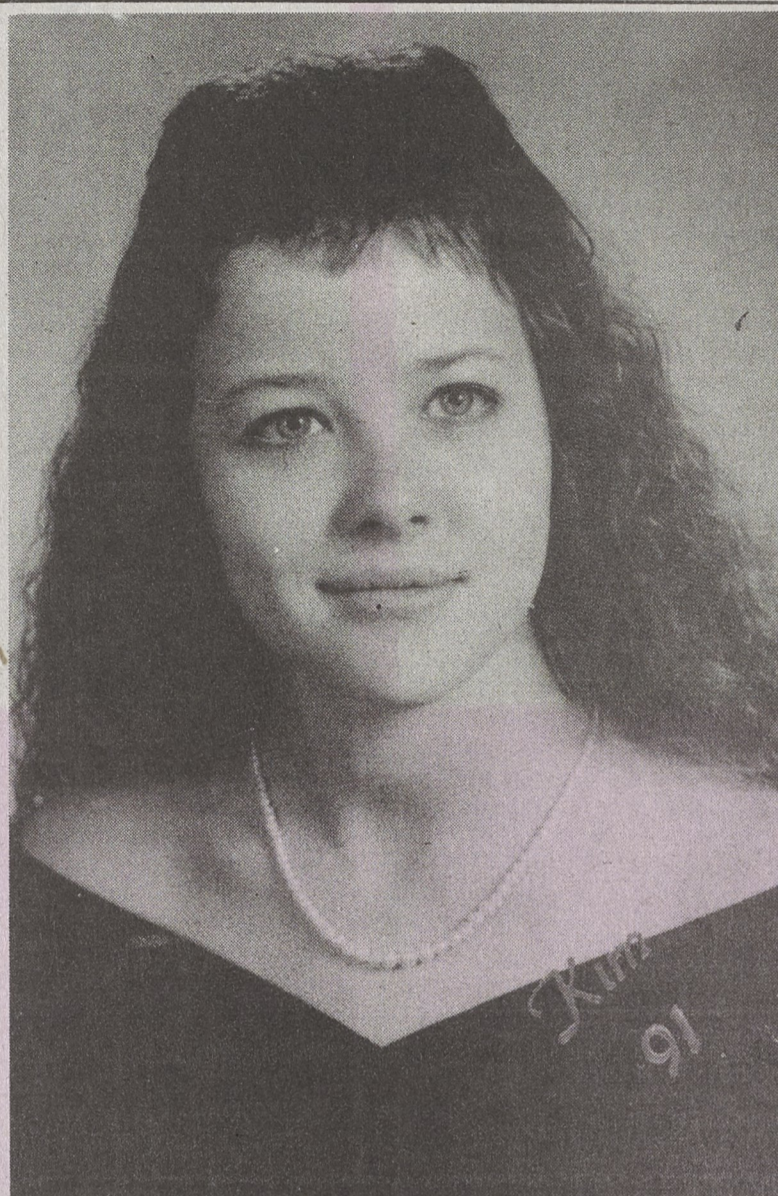
Doris and Larry Rednour hosted the reception. George and Victoria Martin hosted the rehearsal dinner November 6 in the church fellowship hall.
