

Beer, wine referendum in future?

GROVER - A referendum on the off-premise sale of beer and wine could be held as early as spring.

Juanita Pruitt, who is heading up a petition drive for signatures, said Monday night that 123 signatures or 35 percent of the registered voters are required to officially call the referendum.

Pruitt presented a letter from Rob Yelton, county attorney, and the Cleveland County Board of Elections outlining the procedures. The local board has the option of calling the referendum but once the signatures are verified by the elections board, the election can be called by the county board.

Mayor Ronald Queen said no action is necessary by the local council and accepted the petition without reading it into the record. He passed a copy which each member of the board inspected.

Pruitt said a major grocery chain is looking at Grover with an eye to opening a super market. "We need to okay the sale of beer and wine for this establishment. You only have to go just across the railroad tracks to buy in South Carolina," she said.

Pruitt said she will begin circulating the petition this week.

Downtown Grover seeing new growth

GROVER - Downtown Grover is seeing a spurt of new growth and the dozen citizens at Monday's council meeting don't want it to stop.

Bill Lail, who started the ball rolling with major investments in new businesses on Main Street, is refurbishing a 1920's era mule stable and feed room for a karate school which will be heated and air conditioned and include a drop ceiling and dressing rooms.

He asked for and got a reduction from \$350 to \$65 for the water tap to the new business, backed by Jack Pollock and other residents who urged council to give develop-

ers who put up money to broaden the tax base a break. The reduction was based on the premise that the old building fell under the former regulations before the board set new tap fees. "We didn't know there wasn't a tap there or we would have already had it before the rates were changed," said Lail.

Charlotte realtor Marie Callahan acknowledged that a major grocery store chain, a one price shopping store and a hardware company are looking at the area for possible location. "We're talking major dollars but of course it won't be accomplished overnight," she said. "We aren't asking you to give

us anything. We just want to know if Grover wants new business."

Councilman Tim Rowland said that Council is ready to talk to new businesses on an individual basis and look at each situation. "We're not narrow minded."

"We'll give as much incentive as we can for building up Main Street but we would like first to hear about the proposals," said Councilwoman Sandra Ellis.

Callahan said that she represents major companies looking at the area.

"Set a policy to help new developers or Grover will be stagnated," said Pollock. "Look at the physi-

cal and decorative success that Lail has started. Success follows suc-

cess."

"He's put money in this town and shown us an example of small

town aggressiveness," said Pollock.

"Give new businesses a break."

"Projects are coming," said Lail.

"You just can't see them over night."
