Three Kings Mountain wrestlers won championships in the annual Gaston County Tournament Saturday at North Gaston High School.

Senior Robbie Ruff won the 145-pound division and was also named the tournament's most outstanding wrestler. He defeated Joey Davis of Ashbrook 5-0 in the championship match.

Other Kings Mountain winners were Bo Phongsa, who defeated Tracy Philbeck of North Gaston 9-7 for the 140-pound championship; and Cedric Moore, who defeated Brad Eccles of Ashbrook 8-2 to win the 189-pound title.

Phongsa made it to the finals for 'the Mountaineers were Gary the fourth straight year and won his weight class for the third year in a row.

Defending 4-A state champion East Gaston won the team title with 187 points, followed by Ashbrook 177, North Gaston 160, Kings Mountain 123, Shelby 65 1/2, Crest 65, Hunter Huss 64 and South Point 18.
