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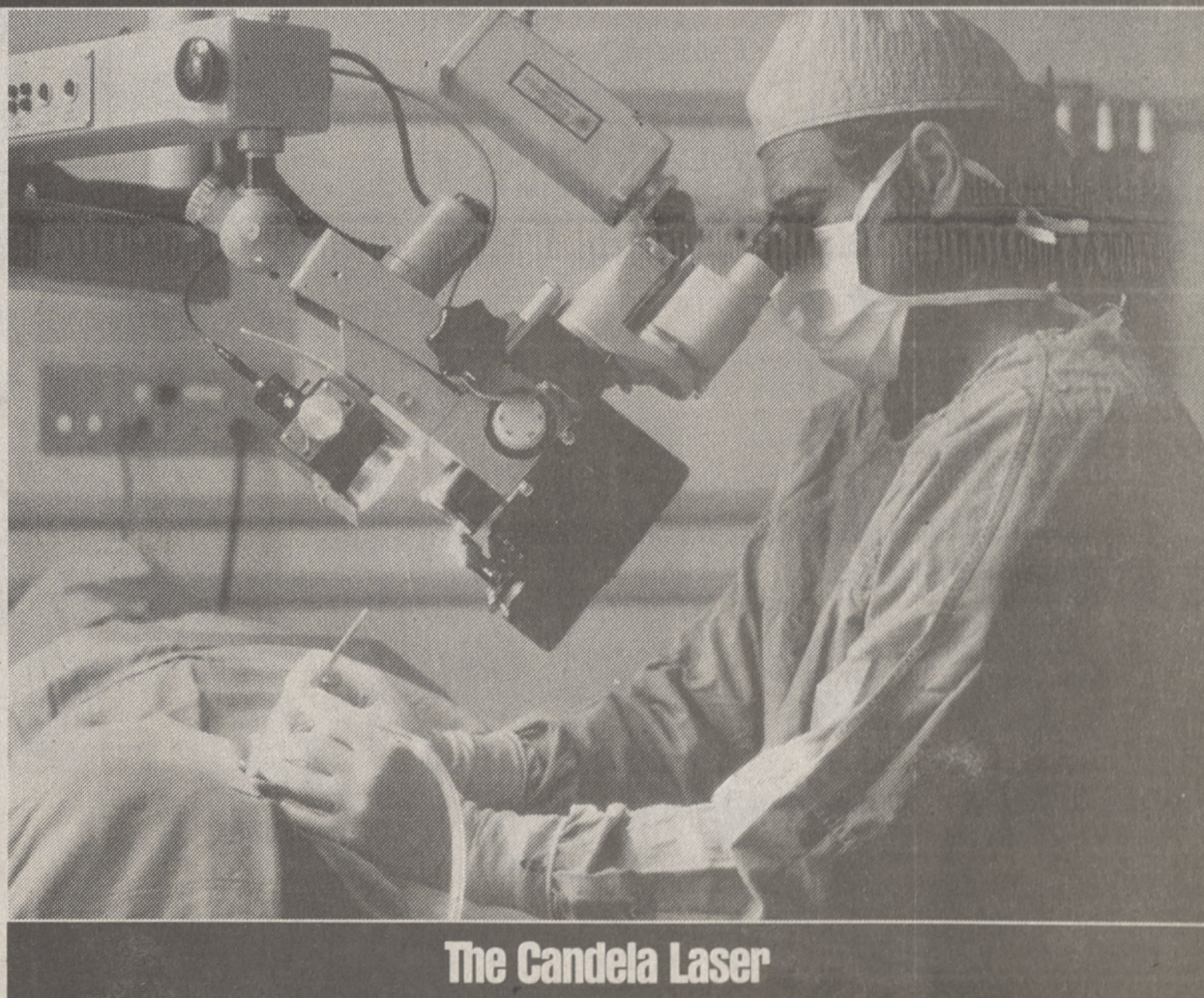
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- "I haven't changed my hairstyle in years. I just don't know what to do with it."
