## Toney participates in program

One Kings Mountain school administrator returned to the classroom last fall to expand his management and leadership skills with new information in areas such as law and curriculum through the Principals' Executive Program at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

Sherrill Toney, principal of West Elementary School, was among 37 principals selected to participate in the university's program for principals and superintendents in the university's program for principals and

superintendents at the Institute of Government. When they completed the 25-day program in April, the principals were more effective school leaders.

The course requires participants to complete 160 hours of classroom work during four months. Besides law and curriculum, other major areas of study include personnel management, communications, self-knowledge, technology and personal development.

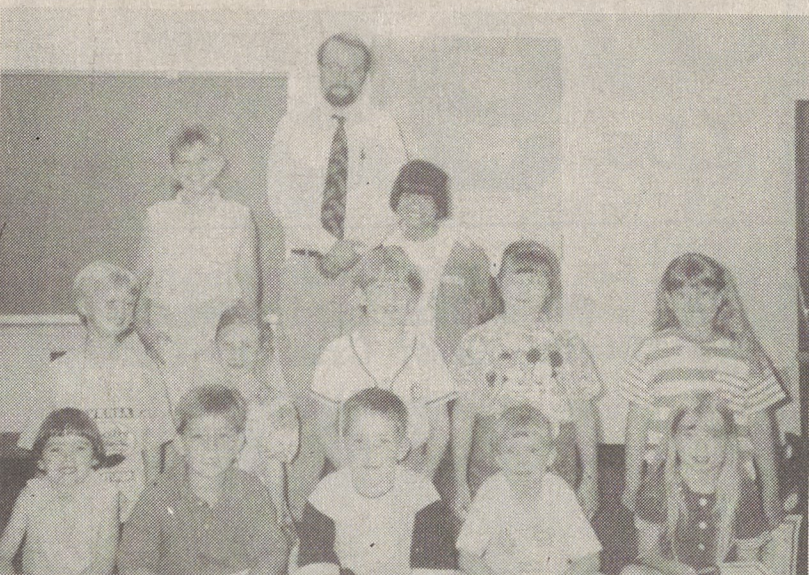
Participants must read, complete study guides and discuss the con-

tents of 13 books, 80 articles and 30 case studies assigned by the 61 faculty members. They must also write papers on their educational philosophy and school leadership. Each must develop a long-range plan to improve an aspect of his or her school.


With the graduation of this group, 1,225 of the state's public school administrators have completed the Principals' Executive Program since it began in September 1984.

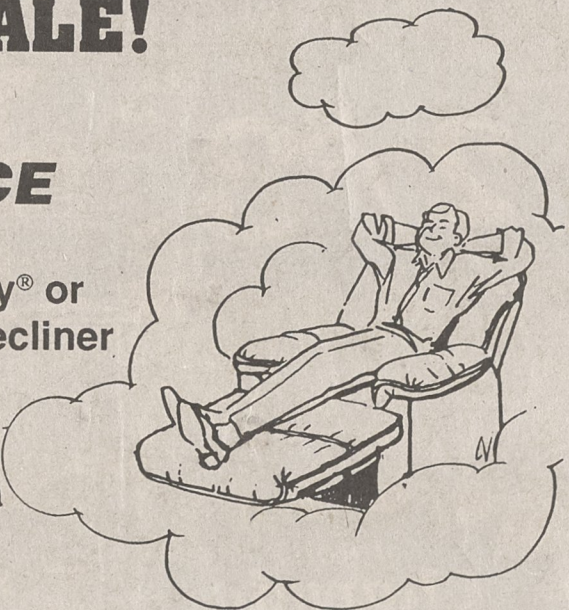
