Groomsmen were Kevin Jenkins, Barry Bumgardner, Robert Depew and Dusty Mullinax, all of Kings Mountain.


The reception was hosted by the bride's parents after the ceremony in the church fellowship hall.

Alecia Denise Moore, daughter of Kevin and Karen Moore of Shelby, celebrated her 6th birthday on Wednesday, May 26.


Alecia also graduated from kindergarten at Victory Christian Academy in Gastonia the same night. She celebrated with her classmates at a reception after graduation.
