Hosting the party were Rance Henderson, Patsy Tart, Kay Davis, Phyllis Roberts, Steve Henderson and Vivian Rikard.

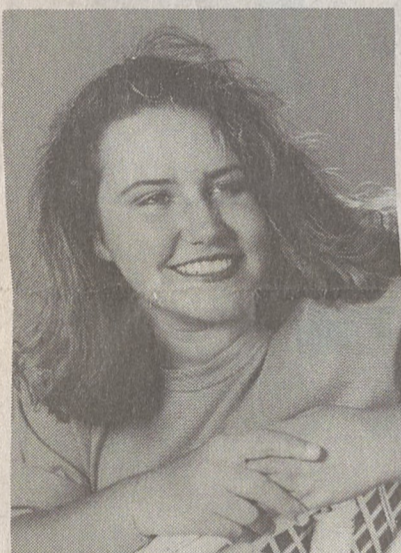
Friends and relatives called from 2:30-4 p.m.

Pioneer Days set at State Park

Applications for crafters for the 17th annual Pioneer Days and Muzzleloaders' Conclave are being accepted through Sept. 3 by the South Carolina Division of State Parks.
