North Carolina law requires children up to age three to ride in a safety seat or booster seat. Children age three up to age six must ride in a safety seat, booster

seat or seat belt. All drivers and front seat passengers must ride buckled up.

Hayes said that to give protection, seat belts must be as snug as possible. Lap belts must be low across the upper thighs, not on the soft tummy. Shoulder belts must be across the shoulder and chest. Do not place the shoulder belt-underthe arm to move it off the neck. Instead move the child toward the center of the car to get a better fit.
