Health care and a proposed tax increase is what worries citizens the most, said McMillan who has met with President Clinton twice to offer constructive suggestions to alterations to the proposed health plan.

McMillan supports the President's North American Free Trade agreement which faces opposition in the House from his own party where Democrats are critical of the deal.

"I can understand the emotional fear that people have but the defeat of this will diminish the U.S., capacity to compete because we'll be making products Mexicans can buy. Mexicans won't be able to pay for them, of course, unless we encourage Mexico's economic growth...

McMillan predicts North Carolinians won't lose jobs if the trade pact is approved, discounting doubts of opponents such as Texas billionaire Ross Perot who says the plan would destroy the middle class and send jobs to Mexico.






