nance defined so that police will know how to enforce it.

During his report, Queen said he received a threatening phone call at 4:30 a.m. Friday. He did not elaborate. "I'm not a quitter and I'll serve my term and not play favorites.

"Take me out of office next time if you don't think I'm doing a good job," he told the 40 people in the audience.

Shortly before his remarks, several women stood and thanked the mayor and board for their service. There was loud applause.

"I've got a lot of bad press recently," said Queen, who said he wanted to set the record straight after being accused of violating the town's animal ordinance by keeping cattle in a pasture near his residence. The only ordinance on the books, according to the attorney, is a vicious dog ordinance.

The new board reappointed Mayor Pro Tem Sandra Ellis, town clerk Lynn Davis and town attorney Mickey Corry and made little changes in commissioner appointments. Jack Herndon was reappointed to the Planning and Zoning Board and also as chairman of the cemetery committee.

The board also set a fee of \$25 for anyone using the town hall, including the Grover Woman's Club, which has been using the facility free for their monthly meetings. After the meeting, several club members said they were disappointed by Council's action when the club raised money for town projects, including equipment for the police car. KJoe owner Kay Saltz offered her business as a free meeting place for the club.
