

Lake Commission discusses fee change

Moss Lake Commission approved requests from two residents Monday night and discussed the upcoming change in fees - \$25 more for annual leases - which were approved recently by City Council.

Donald Greymont's request for dredging was approved subject to his compliance with lake regulations and required amendment to the soil erosion and sedimentation control plan required by the state.

William L. Sanders was given

permission to repair and widen his dock and to extend his jet ski ramp.

Prior to the business, Secretary Gene White administered the oath to all board members, as required under law, and to the new member

of the board, Joe Champion.

Recreation Director Bruce Clark said repairs need to be done to the city's pontoon boat and called attention to clean-up and maintenance projects at the lake.
