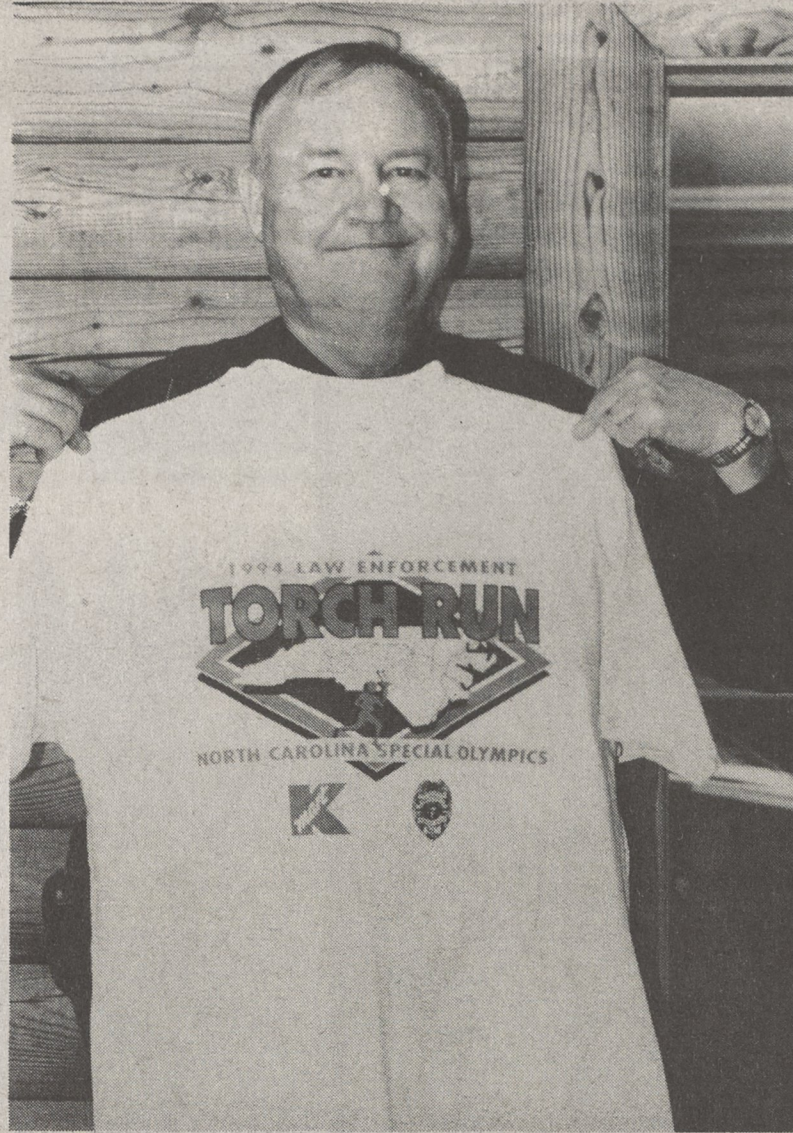

"Kings Mountain people donated in December and January in a heart-warming display of caring

and sharing," said Bolick. "You helped during an emergency and now the 120 hospitals through the two Carolinas, Virginia, Tennessee and Georgia need your help with regular donations."

Bolick said that donors can safely give blood every 56 days, every eight weeks, up to six times a year.

the Food Stamp Program, Supplementary Security Income, Medicaid and Medicare Buy-In.

Bell said that the local Senior Center is trying to reach those people in the Kings Mountain area who may benefit from these services.
