## Bethany reunion Sunday

The Bethany Elementary PTO Mountain View, Santiago, Zadok, and volunteers from the Bethany community will host the "Bethany Historical Program and Exhibit" Sunday, May 22 at 2 p.m. at Bethany Elementary School, located on Maynard Grayson Road near Clover, SC.

The primary purpose of the program is to recognize students who attended the feeder schools which consolidated into Bethany and to also recognize students who attended Bethany High School, which existed until 1946.

At this time, there are records of 23 schools in the Bethany area, including Adams, Allison Creek, Battleground, Bethany, Bethany Presbyterial Boarding School, Bowling Green, Buffalo Church, Center Hill, Clarks Fork, Crawford, Cross Roads, Davis, Dixie, Fairfield, Fairview, Flint Hill, Hambright, Henry, Hero,

and Zoar. Former students from at least eight of the schools are still in

The exhibit will be open immediately after the program. It will consist of 80 photographs dating from 1903-46, text books, including a 1851 copy of "The Pictorial Primer," school rolls from 10 of the schools dating from 1886-1930, copies of "The Bethany Blab" newspaper from the 1940s, and many other items of interest. Volunteers will be stationed at each exhibit table to record information guests may provide concerning the Bethany schools.

A professional photographer will be present to make pictures of each school group. Photographs may be purchased for \$10 for an 8 x 10.

The Bethany PTO will have 195 Historical Calendars available for sale May 13. Nineteen photographs dating from 1903-41 will be displayed on the calendars with approximately 300 former Bethany students pictured. The cost is \$8. All profits will go toward the expense of the historical project and for PTO expenses. Donations will be accepted also.

All former students of the schools and the public are invited to attend the event. Students are asked to bring old photographs. Sam Thomas of the Historical Center of York County will be present with his photography equipment. Photos will be copied and immediately handed back.
