ing a gun, pistol or rifle; explosives, including a bomb, grenade, or mine; knife, including a pocket knife, bowie knife, switchblade, dirk, or dagger; and other weapons including slingshot, slungshot, leaded cane, blackjack, metal knuckles, BB gun, air rifle, air pistol, stun gun or other electric shock weapon, icepick, razor, or razor blade, or any sharp pointed or edged instrument except unaltered nail files and clips and tools used solely for preparation of food, instruction, and maintenance; or a facsimile of a gun, incendiary device, or other object that can reasonably be considered a weapon or dangerous instrument.

If it agrees with the recommendations, the Board would approve them after a second reading at the August meeting.

Several other items are on the agenda, including:

■ 1994 budget amendments and approval of an interim 1994-95 budget which is necessary until the system receives official notification from government agencies on the amount of funds it will receive.

■ Approval of bread and milk bids for the 1994-95 child nutrition program.

■ A citizen presentation by Tom Sees, who will ask questions on parent involvement and the history of the Family Life curriculum.

■ An executive session to hear concerns of Melany and Danny Bolin.

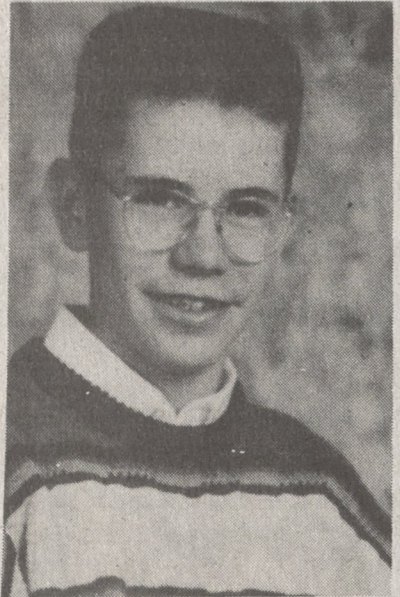

ground. The stands of Jake Early Field were packed and hundreds of people stood on ball fields and in the parking areas to watch.

The city contracted Melrose Pyrotechnics of Van Wyck, SC to do the fireworks, and they put on a very professional show.

"They shot over 200 shells," Clark said, "and there were only three that didn't go off. There was one six-inch shell that actually exploded down in the tube and that could have been a very dangerous situation, but by us contracting the job out we were not in any way responsible for that. In a lot of ways contracting the show was good for us. If there had been some damage we would not have been responsible."

Clark said he has heard no complaints about the day's activities and feels the entire celebration brought a positive image to Kings Mountain.
