23 when the marchers set out from Dunn's Meadow near Abington, Va. The modern day patriots were joined by other marchers along the original route of the Overmountain Men, departing from Cowpens National Battlefield for their final trek to Kings Mountain.

On Saturday and Sunday the Guilford Militia will recreate the activities of military camp life during the 18th century and of an 18th century muster. The encampment will not only feature military drilling with musket and rifle demonstrations but will offer camp cooking, basket weaving, bullet and button molding and other crafts. A field hospital will house the regimental surgeon who will be discussing Revolutionary War medicine.
