Kings Mountain woman injured by storm drain

A Kings Mountain woman was treated for injuries Saturday afternoon in the Kings Mountain Hospital Emergency Room after she accidentally fell into a storm drain in front of Billy's Automotive.

Kathy Sue Maoney, 44, of 401 Walnut St., had been watching the 3:30 p.m. Kings Mountain Christmas Parade.

She told City Ptl. Rena Rikard that she moved over in the street to let someone pass by and stepped on the edge of the storm drain cover and it gave away and she fell into the storm drain.


