The state's unemployment rate has remained at or near the lowest of the 11 large states surveyed by the federal government. In November the state unemployment rate was 4.2 percent.

In the period from August to November, the state's net employment rose more than 36,000 jobs.

Job creation in a wide variety of service jobs such as trade, real estate, finance and insurance are predicted for the new year. Nearly 25 percent of the state's work force is employed in the manufacturing sector and local officials see manufacturing employment as remaining relatively steady. Southerland says he sees some strengths in the eco-


