There was a trace of snow on January 3 and 23, and February 7. There was a trace of ice or sleet on January 6 and 29, and February 9 and 10.

The last spring freeze was on March 9, and the last spring frost was on April 24. The first fall frost was on October 28 and the first freeze was on November 4.
