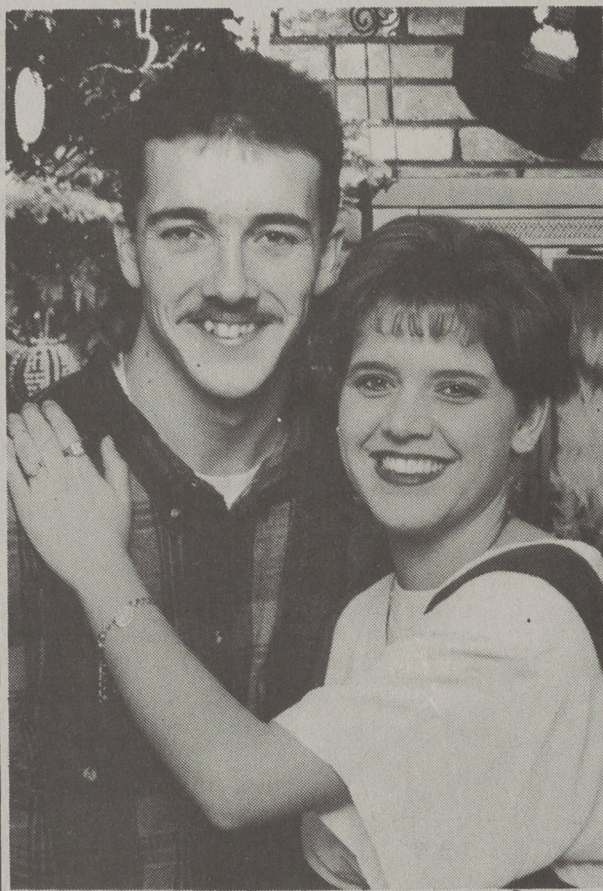

Compost bins available to public

With spring's arrival, do-it-yourself recycling is swinging in high gear thanks to efforts of Kings Mountain Garden Club and the City of Kings Mountain.

Backyard composting is actually less work than bagging and dragging to the curb, says Public Works Supt. Karl Moss who says homeowners can buy the bins at about half what they would pay for an equivalent bin anywhere else.

Moss says the 100 percent recycled plastic bins are simple to use

because they require no assembly - the homeowner simply unfolds the three foot by three foot bin which may be used without turning the material. No additives are required.

The Groundskeeper bin is available again this spring for \$13.87. Also available is a high quality Soilsaver, a 30-pound bin with its own locking lid and 25-year limited warranty. The Soilsaver costs \$49.85 in Kings Mountain but is featured in a number of garden catalogs for \$90-\$100 plus shipping.

Moss said that due to bulk shipping, minimum packaging and the absence of any retail mark-up, citizens are able to obtain these bins at the reduced prices by signing up at the Public Works Department, 1013 N. Piedmont Ave., or call 734-0735. Homeowners may call toll free at 1-800-595-6446 by using Master Card, VISA, Discover Card or a personal check.

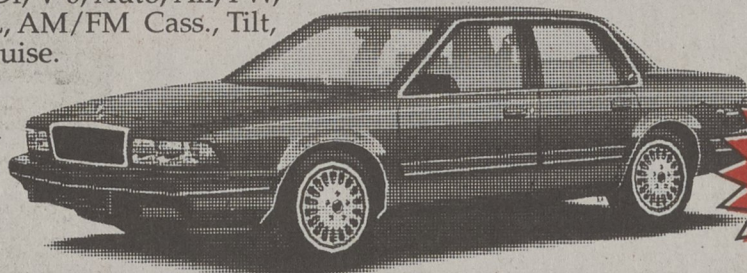

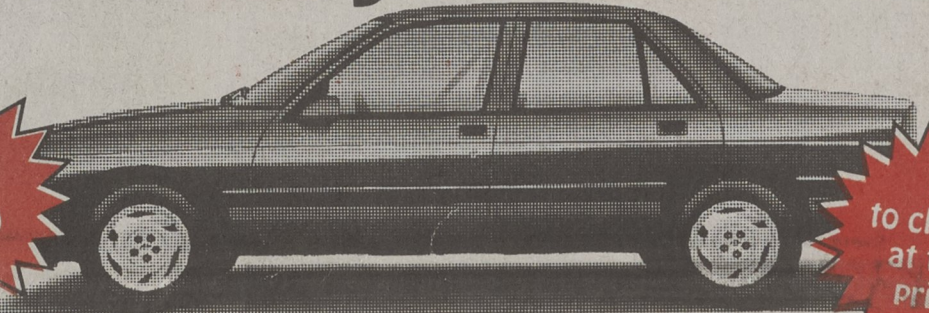
