New fiction at Mauney Memorial Library:

Asimov, Issac. "Gold" (Harper Prism, 1995).

This is Asimov's first original collection of science fiction in over a decade. It is also his last science fiction collection, one containing all of his uncollected stories that have never before appeared in book form.

Finney, Jack. "From Time to Time" (Simon & Schuster, 1995).

A sequel to "Time and Again" Finney returns to the same magical territory and finds Ruben Prien still at work with the project, still dreaming of altering man's fate by going back in time to adjust events. Finney has invented a tale that is both thrilling and nostalgic and full of suspense.

LeGuin, Ursula. "A Fisherman of the Inland Sea" (Harper Prism, 1994).

This new collection of short fiction by one of Americas most honored authors celebrates her understanding that narrative is the shining thread with which we write our common humanity.

McCaffrey, Anne. "The Dolphins of Pern" (Ballantine Books, 1994).

When the first humans came to settle the planet Pern, they did not come alone; intelligent enchanted dolphins also crossed the stars to colonize the oceans of the new planet while the human partners settled the vast continents. But then disaster struck in the form of Thread, deadly silver spores that fell like rain from the sky, devouring everything and everyone in their path.

lished for the first time - a continuation of the great saga of Turin Turambar and his sister Nienar.

Weldon, Fay. "Splitting" (Atlantic Monthly Press, 1995).

This novel swoops with dizzying ease among the conflicting perspectives of a woman whose personality in the face of her impending divorce, has slivered into a chorus of bickering interior voices, each with its own very distinctive tone and agenda.

Wetherall, W.D. "The Wisest Man in America" (University of Press of New England, 1995).

Wetherall creates a bittersweet retrospective that is at once profoundly meditative on the intricacies of human relationships and full of insight into the diminishment of the American national character.

White, Robin. "The Last High Ground" (Crown Publishers, Inc., 1995).

Reaching from the deathbed of Japan's most notorious organized crime boss to terror 40,000 feet above the Rocky Mountains, a scheme of unparalleled subtlety and brutality unfolds. It's target: the hostile takeover and control of the greatest aircraft manufacturer in the United States and ultimately control of the entire world's aerospace industry.

Williamson, Penelope. "Heart of the West" (Simon & Schuster, 1995).

On a vast canvas dotted with memorable characters and none rousing adventure after another, Williamson has created an irresistible work of fiction that combines the heroic and the gritty.

Winter, J.D.M. "First Trail Drive" (M. Evans and Company, Inc., 1994).

Before there was a United States of America, two unsung heroes embarked on an epic journey to aid their struggling new country's fight for independence. It would be known as the first trail drive. Ben and Ezra are the epitome of the American frontiersmen, courageous, resourceful, determined, and they would not be prevented from their fight for independence.

Wolff, Geoffrey. "The Age of Consent" (Alfred A. Knopf, 1995).

The stunning new book is a haunting portrait of a perfect family and idyllic community torn apart by the secrets that shadow and corrupt their homes.

Woodson, Jacqueling. "Autobiography of a Family Photo" (Dutton, 1995).

This is a coming to consciousness, coming of age story of a young girl, told with passion and poetry, honest and clear vision.
