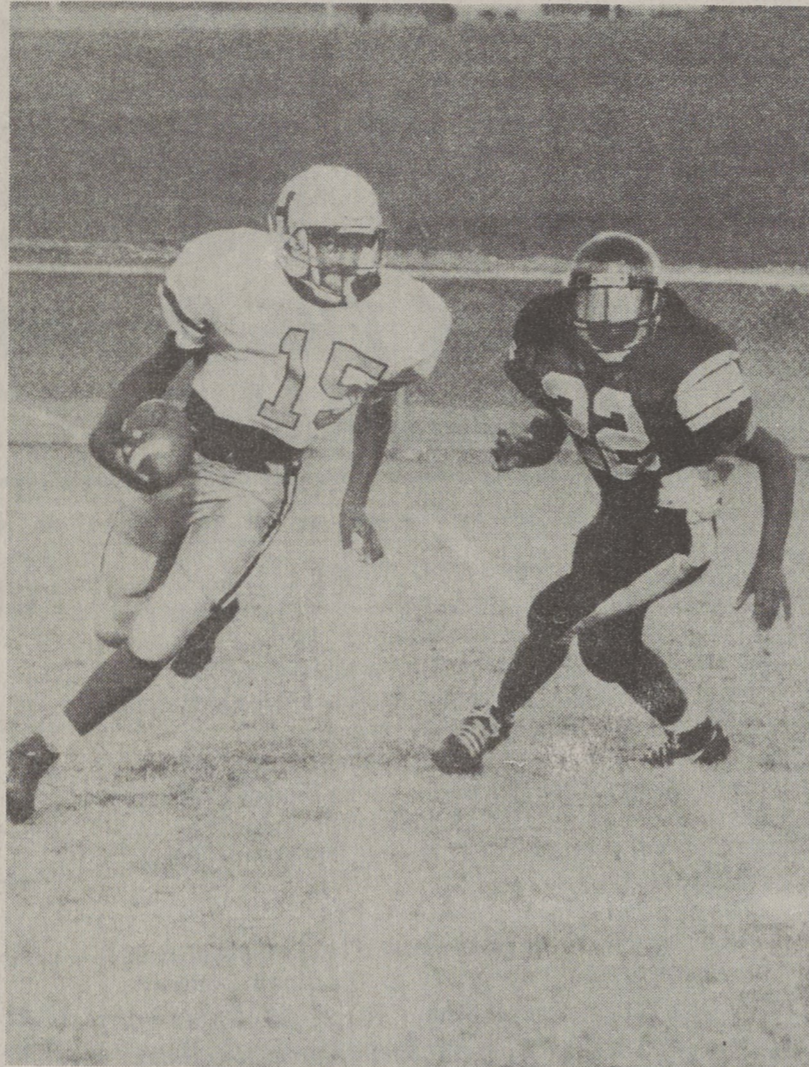
## GW drops volleyball match to Lincoln


