Carroll retains kick boxing title

The Professional Karate Federation middleweight world champion Gary "Explosive Thin Man" Carroll of Kings Mountain added another victory to his 13-0 record last weekend at the Kings Mountain Community Center.

His opponent, Tommy Battone of Mastic, NY, the Intercontinental champion for the P.K.F., put up a good fight but Carroll's control of the ring in all rounds gave him a unanimous decision.

Robert Eng, Carroll's trainer, said Carroll was under a lot of stress after his grandmother died two days before the fight. "But Gary is a true champion," said Eng. "He loves to fight and train hard, and he is always thinking of pleasing the crowd he fights for. He has a large following in Western North Carolina. Most of his fights are out of town or the country, but we will try to fight at least once or twice a year in Kings Mountain."

Carroll's next bout will be in Atlantic City, NJ.
