## 300 students attend health fair at KMMS

A health fair at Kings Mountain Middle School Thursday attracted 300 eighth graders.

Health nurse Betty Masters and county school consultant Sue Martin arranged the program which included cholesterol and blood pressure checks, height, weight, vision and lung assessment centers, a safety demonstration on the proper use of seat belts, a presentation by the Kings Mountain D. A. R. E. officer Lisa Capps and tetanus vaccinations for students who had received parental permission.

Physician Assistant, and volunteers with the Cleveland County Health Department assisted other volunteers in the program. Lois Owens, home economist with the Cleveland County Extension Service, manned a booth about good nutrition and talked with students about nutrition.

"We appreciated all the volunteer assistance in the health fair which we try to have on an annual basis," said Mrs. Masters.

Outside on the school grounds representatives of the State Highway Patrol demonstrated seat belt safety.

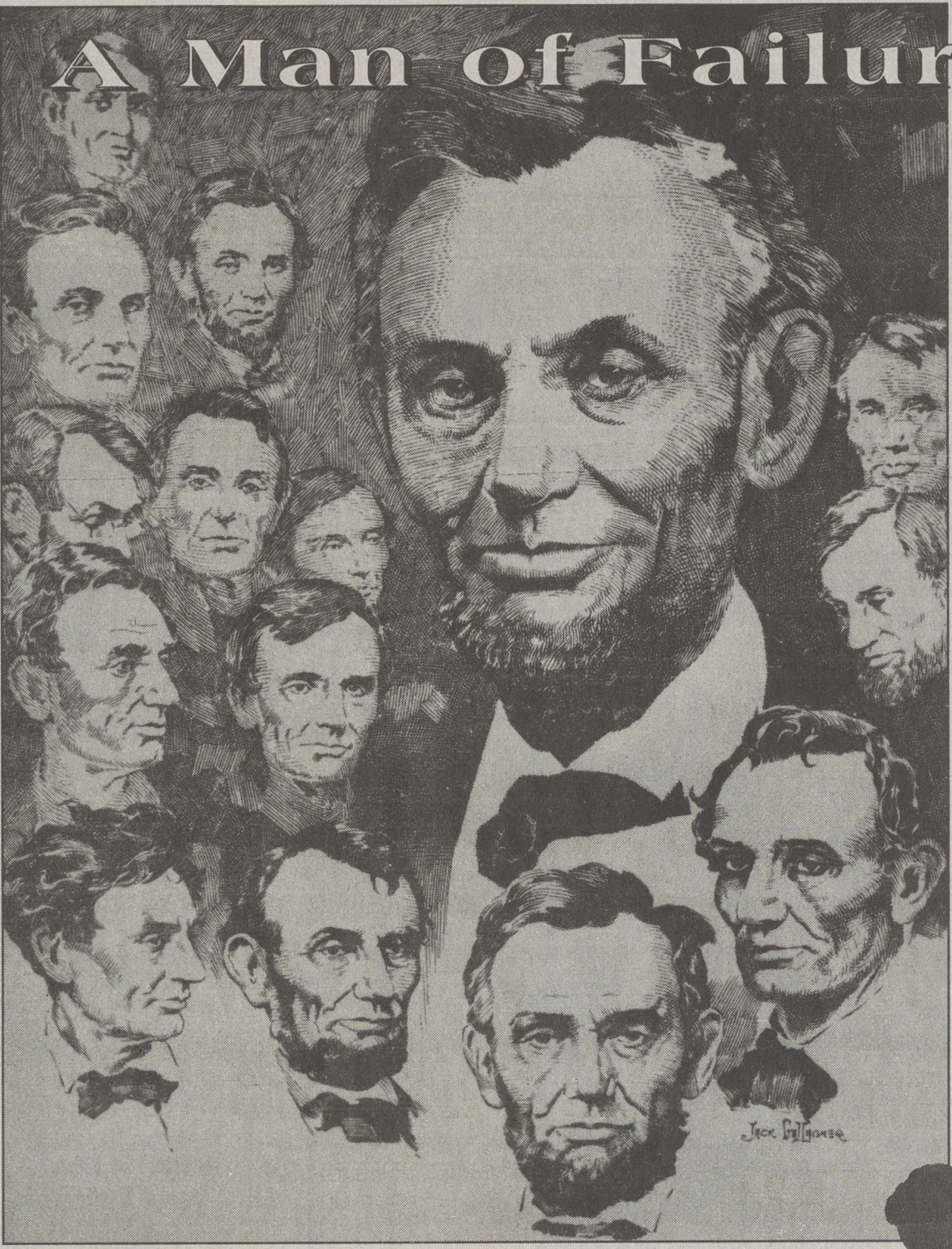
