### KMHS junior Jaime Sherrill attends Presidential Classroom

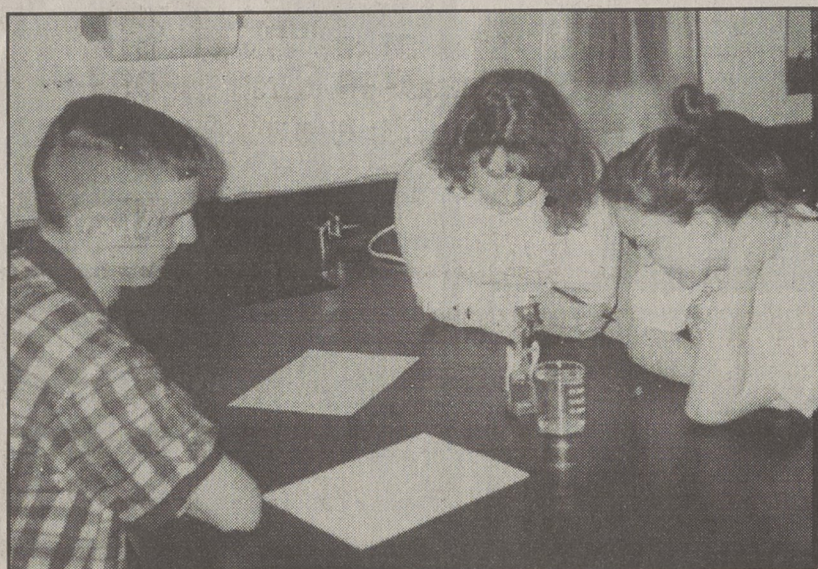
Jaime Sherrill, junior at Kings Mountain School, is back from the 29th annual Presidential Classroom in Washington, DC.

She was selected by the faculty as a representative to the program which attracted 246 high school juniors and seniors from 34 states, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico and Honduras.

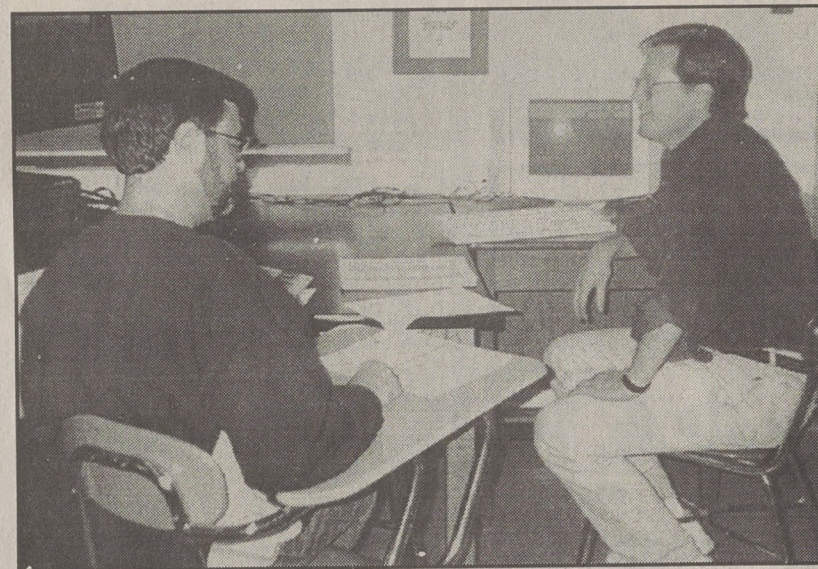
Learning about the Democratic process firsthand was an experience for Sherrill who was at the White House for the welcoming ceremony for French President Jacques Chirac, attended seminars at the Departments of Agriculture

and the floor of the House of Representatives and visited foreign embassies. She also met with Republican Congresswoman Sue Myrick on Capitol Hill and attended Congressional sessions and committee hearings.

The 1996 Flagship Program addressed some of the most controversial and current issues facing American leadership, Sherrill said. Students also attended Crossfire discussions on each branch of the government and current issues, and visited the monuments, memorials and treasures of the capital city.
