Erica Yates celebrates fourth birthday July 3

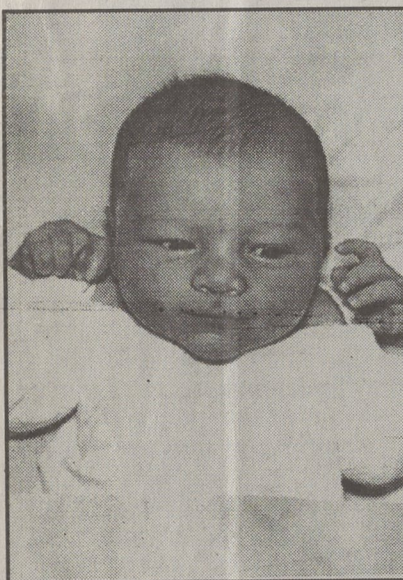
Erica Yates, daughter of Gary and Peggy Yates of Kings Mountain, is four years old today.

JORDAN MICHAEL HEATH

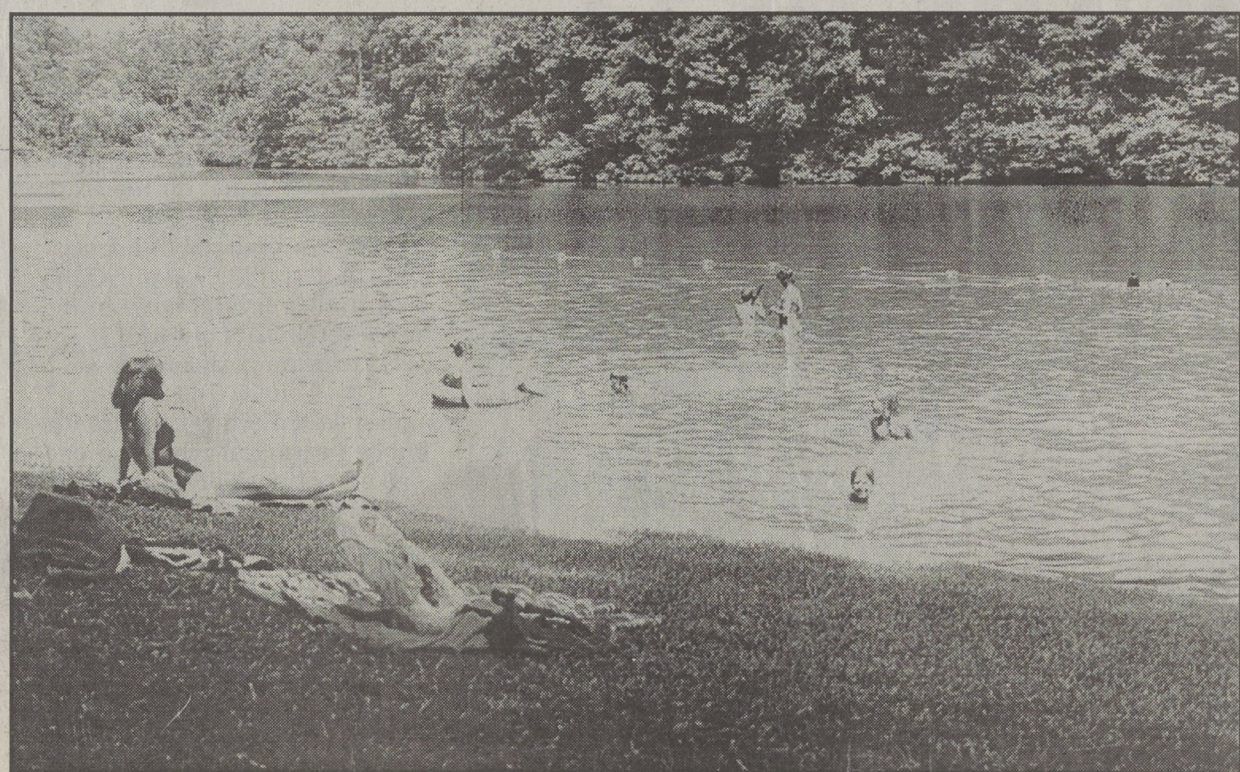
Jordan Michael Heath born on May 28, 1996
