Monica Scism attended the bride as maid of honor.

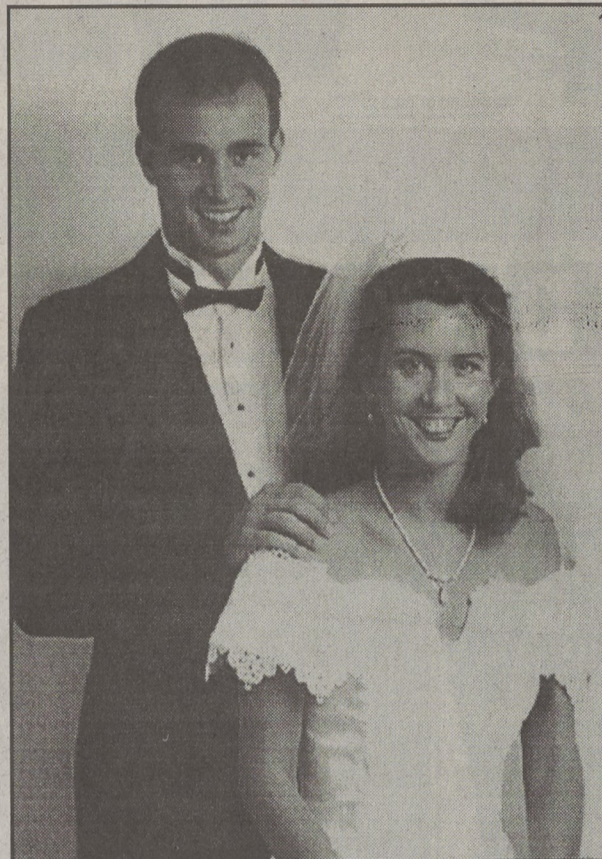
Groomsmen were Mitch Johnston, John Bridges, Stoney Parham and Marcus Scism.
