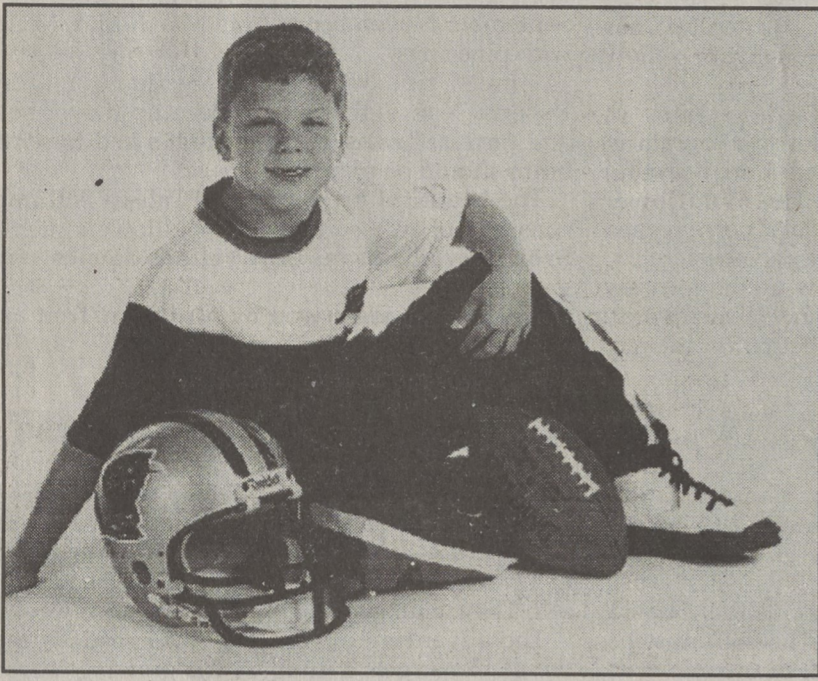


Birthdays

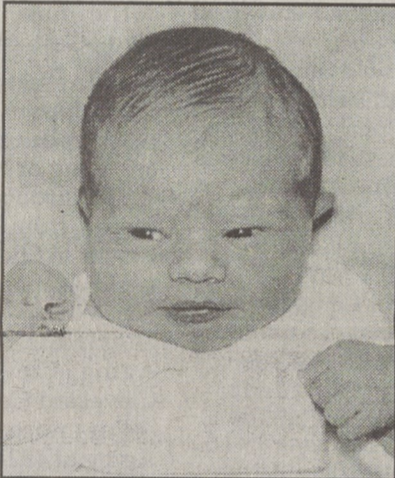
Cameron Bullock

Maternal grandparents are Merrill and Jean Randall. Paternal grandparents are Johnny and Deborah Melton.

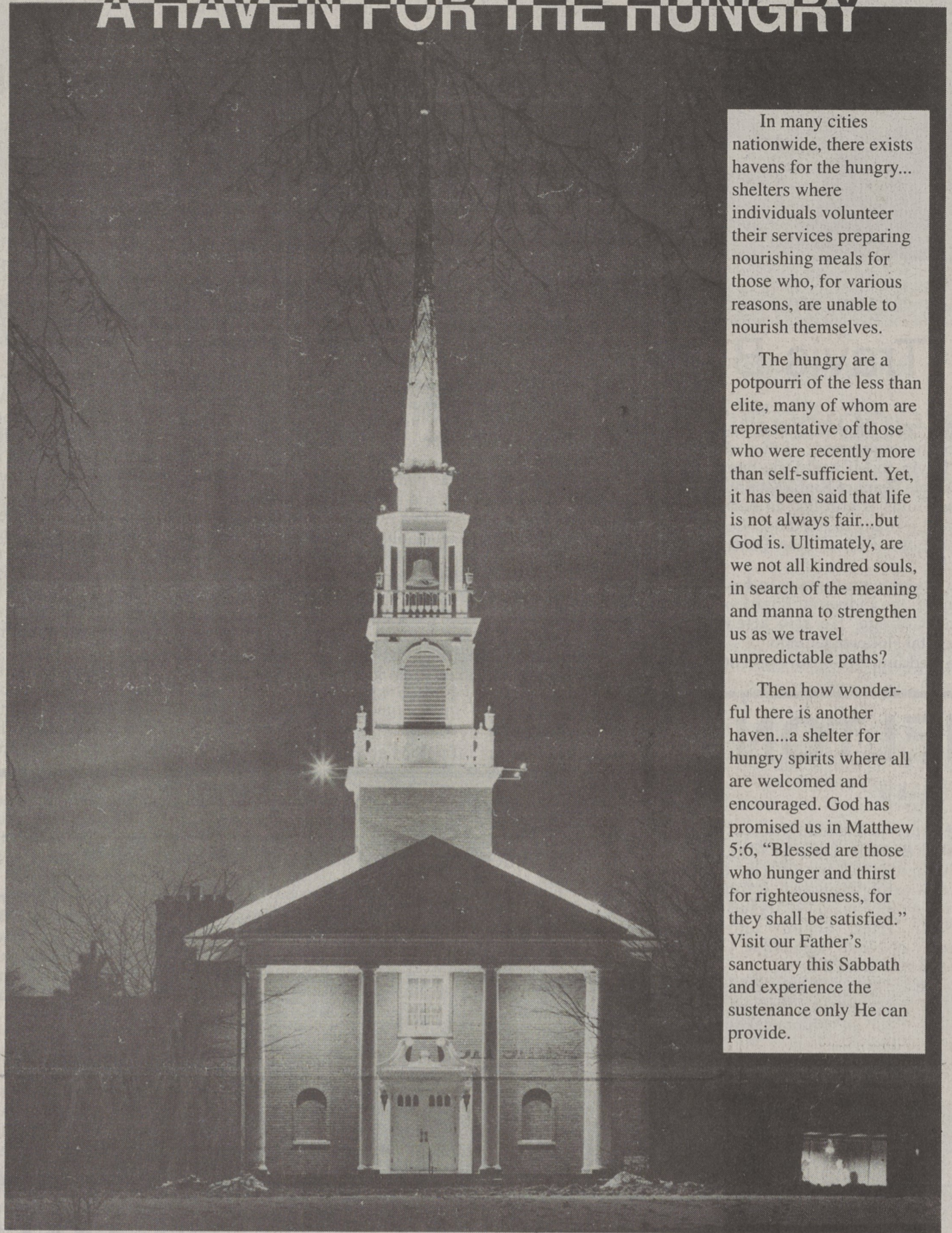
