From Page 2 irritating skin, fleas can also cause tapeworm infestations, behavioral changes and, in young or very old

animals, anemia. But you can battle flea attacks if you take the proper steps. Outside the house, apply a proven product such as Sevin® brand carbaryl insecticide to shrubs, woody areas, around entranceways and to areas where your pet sleeps or rests. Inside your home, wash your pet's blankets and other bedding material in hot, soapy water. Be sure to vacuum your carpets and upholstered furniture regularly, paying special attention to crevices and corners near baseboards where fleas love to hide. Immediately dispose of the vacuum bag so that it will not become a breeding ground for fleas in your closet.


