

# Eight people charged in two Kings Mountain drug busts

Eight people were arrested on drug charges Thursday and Friday in drug raids at 712 Cansler Street and 310 Somerset Drive.

The Cleveland County Sheriff's Department, assisted by the Kings Mountain Police Department, executed a search warrant at 712 Cansler Street Thursday.

The Cleveland County Sheriff's Department Narcotics and Vice Division and C. O. P.

Unit, assisted by the Kings Mountain Police Department, executed a search warrant Friday at 310 Somerset Drive.

Vice/Narcotics Sgt. Joel Shores said a search of the Cansler Street residence yielded cocaine, marijuana, four handguns, one of which had been reported stolen, crack pipes, other assorted drug paraphernalia and \$800 in cash.

Lt. Billy Benton said a search of the Somerset residence resulted after numerous complaints from residents in the Somerset area.

"We encountered 11 people in the Cansler Street residence and found several of them using controlled substances," said Shores who said sheriff's deputies and police had conducted three other searches at the home of Andrea Robbs over the past three years. Shores said the other search warrants were served at Robbs' residence at 102 Thompson Drive in Kings Mountain.

Charged in the Cansler Street drug bust were:

Andrea Lamont Robbs, 30, of 712 Cansler St., possession of

coaine, maintaining a dwelling to use a controlled substance and possession of drug paraphernalia. According to Shores, Robbs has a previous conviction of a drug related charge.

Joyce Diane Gantt, 37, 413 Gant Lane, Vale, possession of drug paraphernalia.

Shelia Anita Williams, 39, Carolina Garden Apartments, possession of drug paraphernalia.

Phillip Bern Pendleton, 43, 117 Dayview Dr., Grover, possession of marijuana.

Raphel Williams, 18, of 201

Parrish Dr., possession of marijuana.

The investigation is continuing, according to Shores, and other charges are pending.

Benton said three suspects were arrested as a result of the search at the home of Todd Connor on Somerset Drive where police confiscated numerous items of drug paraphernalia along with trace amounts of suspected cocaine. They included: Avery Cornelius Starr, 21, 719 Belfast St.; Tiffany Shenea Starr, 21, 525 Elizabeth Drive; and Anthony Ratchford,

36, 719 Belfast Dr., all of Gastonia. All three suspects were charged with trafficking in cocaine and placed in the Cleveland County Detention Center in lieu of \$100,000 bond.

Benton said the suspects were arrested in the parking lot of the Kings Mountain ABC Store while in the process of allegedly delivering the crack cocaine. Benton said street value of the approximately one ounce of cocaine is \$6,000.

The investigation is continuing, according to Benton, and more arrests are expected.
