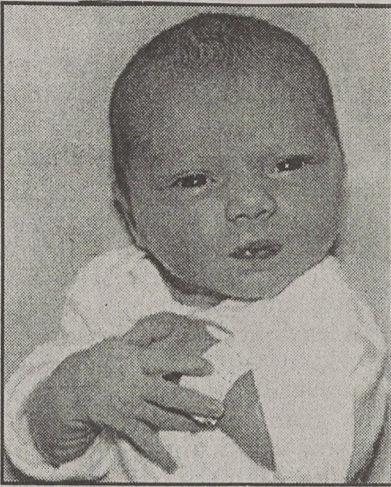
All prize winners in each class will be able to enter the

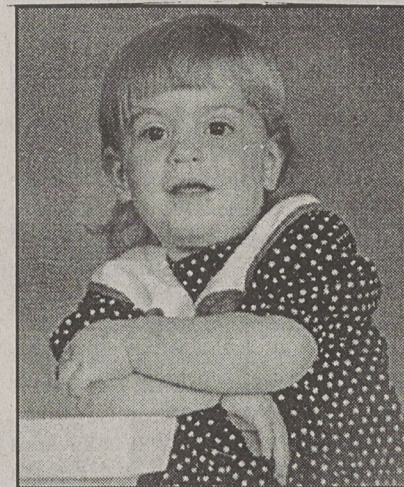
McKENZIE SHAYNE GIBSON

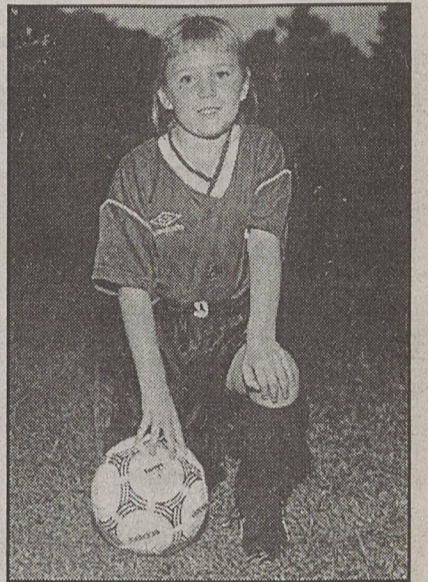
Reagan Childers

There will be a singing October 26 at 6 p.m. at Harvest Baptist Church, 144 Ware Road, Kings Mountain.

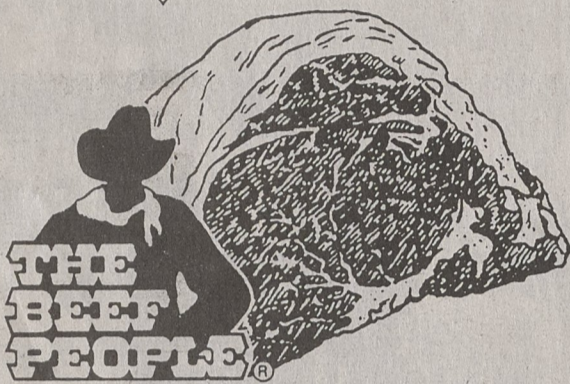
