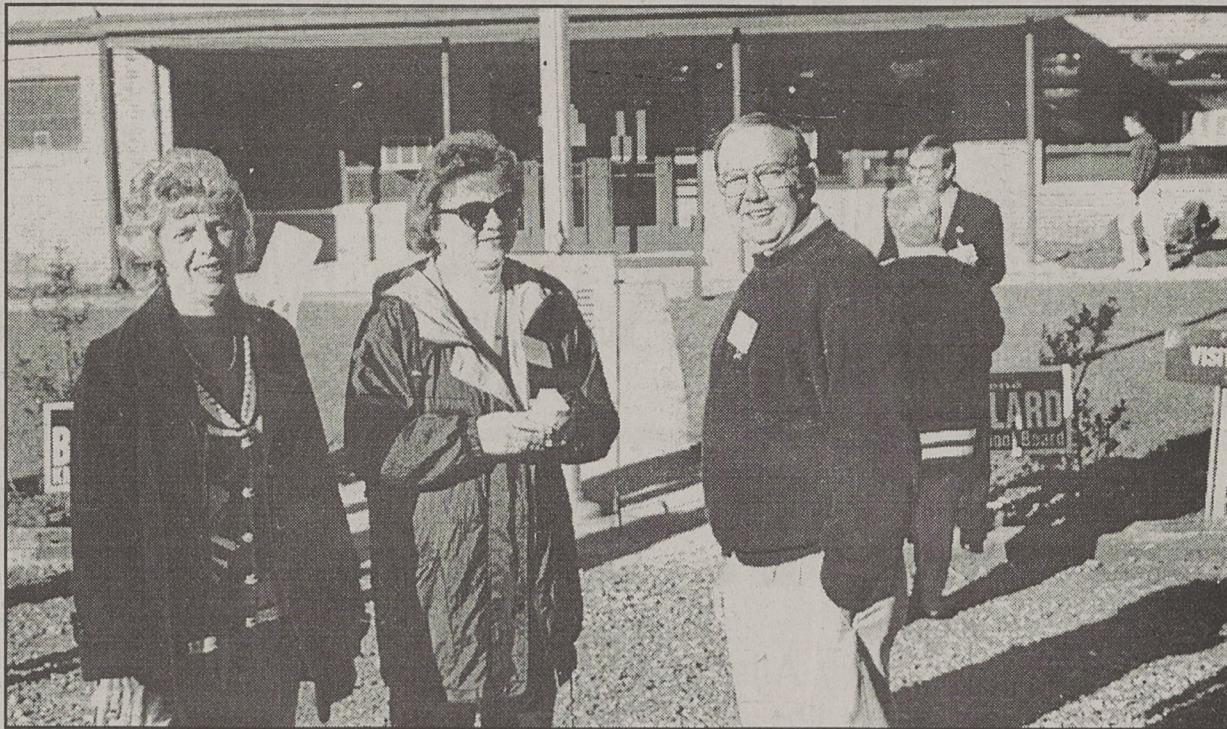
She was preceded in death by her husband, the late Alex Talmadge "Red" Randall Jr., and her sister, Barbara S. Barnes.
