WRECKS

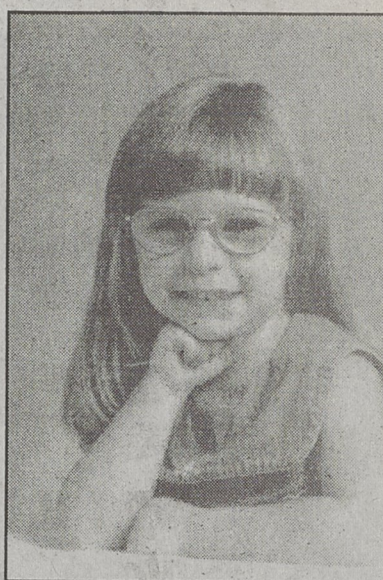
